### **CANCELLATION POLICY**

Cancellations and refunds for students under the age of 18, must be submitted by a parent or legal guardian. Any supporting documentation in connection with a cancellation or refund request must be received in writing no later than May 31, 2017. Participants and parents further understand and agree that once a STEAM Scholar has been enrolled in the conference, the following cancellation fees will apply to tuition and any addition add-on service as applicable.

### **Cancellation Received by Project Fibonacci® Eligible Refund:**

- Registrations cancelled more than 60 days before the event will be refunded the balance of the paid registration fee, less a nonrefundable \$500 deposit.
- Registrations cancelled less than 60 but more than 30 days before the event will be refunded 50% of the paid registration fee.
- Registrations cancelled 30 days or less before the event will not be eligible for a refund.

### CODE OF CONDUCT

Participants are expected to follow program expectations to ensure safety and a high-quality learning experience. The intent of this code is for attendees to be familiar with and strictly adhere to this Code of Conduct in its entirety. The student's practice of carrying out the code of conduct results in generating a constructive setting that is conducive to a positive learning environment, teambuilding, enhanced decision making skills and safety for each participant.

- I. **Behavior Code:** Positive behavior exemplifies citizenship, respect, responsibility, compassion, understanding and integrity. It a key expectation for youth and adults participating in the Project Fibonacci® program. Participants are responsible for fostering an environment that is free of disruptive behavior, avoid threats to persons or property, and supports individual rights. Students shall not use inappropriate language, gestures or any other actions that will hurt or could be offensive to others. Students are encouraged to promptly report violations or a suspected breach in this code.
- II. **Dress Code:** Participants must dress appropriately for the occasion and be neat and clean in appearance. Casual dress is acceptable and typically includes pants, khakis, cargo shorts, shirts, dresses (all at appropriate length). Unacceptable wear includes spaghetti straps, midriff shirts/blouses and tasteless verbiage on clothing. Full closed shoes or clean sneakers are acceptable.
- III. **Bullying Policy:** Teasing and bullying are forbidden; conduct that violates the rights of others is banned. Teasing and bullying, disrespect or violating the rights of others with regards to an individual's race, age, sexual orientation, religion, national origin, disability, genetic background or appearance are strictly forbidden. Disciplinary action will be taken.
- IV. **Drug/Alcohol Policy:** Use of illegal drugs, alcohol, tobacco, nicotine products (including electronic cigarettes and chewing tobacco), theft, vandalism or leaving the premises without permission is forbidden and will be strictly enforced.
- V. **Lodging Policy:** Room assignments are made by the conference organizers. Participants are not permitted to change room assignments or to enter an unassigned hotel room. - VI. **Curfew Policy:** Students must observe the 11:00 PM restriction. All participants must be in their assigned rooms by 10:30 PM and remain in their assigned room for the duration of the evening. Quiet hours are from 11:00 PM-6:00 AM.
- VII. **Personal Belongings:** Students are responsible for their own belongings. Valuables such as jewelry or large sums of money should be left at home. Personal electronic devices are the responsibility of the student. Project Fibonacci® sponsors shall not be responsible for lost, damaged or stolen items.
- VIII. Our primary consideration is to provide a safe and secure environment. Staff members are responsible for enforcing the rules of conduct and these rules are not subject to interpretation. Each program participant is expected to follow them without exception.
- IX. **Judicial Board Policy:** A staff judicial board is in place to review allegations of a student's breach of this Code of Conduct which may proceed to a hearing with the Board, if necessary. Disciplinary action will vary based on the degree of the offense. The Board will make a recommendation that may include notification to local law enforcement. Participants who commit any violation of the Code of Conduct shall be asked to leave and will be sent home at their own expense.
