
Steps for Scholars to Attend the 2025 STEAM Leadership Conference:

	Self-Nomination: Complete the Scholar Self-Nomination Form: All interested scholars must fill out this form to express their interest in attending the conference.
	Reference Nomination Form: <i>New Scholars Only</i> If you are a new scholar, ensure that a Reference Nomination Form is completed and submitted on your behalf.
	Schedule a Virtual Interview: New Scholars Only: After both forms are received, the registration chairperson will reach out to schedule a virtual interview. The interview will include the potential STEAM Scholar and their parent/guardian and will be conducted with our Admissions Board.
	Admissions Decision: Await Acceptance Notice: The Admissions Board will review your interview and notify you of your acceptance into the program.
	Registration: Early Bird registration starts on Monday, March 10th. Register as soon as possible to secure your spot. Pay Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$250 is required upon registration. This can be paid via credit card or check.
	Financial Planning: After registration and deposit payment, our financial support team will contact your parent/guardian to discuss payment plan options and answer any questions regarding tuition assistance. Review Payment Dates: If participating in a payment plan, ensure you and your family review the payment schedule.
	Fundraising and Scholarships: Scholars are encouraged to fundraise to show initiative in supporting their tuition. Submit Scholarship Funding Applications: Apply for any available scholarships to assist with tuition costs.
	Conference Preparation: Our team will provide updates on the conference schedule, special announcements, and workshop preselection.

CONFERENCE TUITION

We are committed to providing an enriching and exceptional experience for all participants. To continue offering the best possible conference, we must make a necessary adjustment to our tuition fees.

Starting in 2025, the tuition new scholars will be updated from \$1,500 to \$1,895. This decision was not made lightly and reflects the rising costs associated with maintaining the high quality of our program. Returning Scholars tuition rate for 2025 is \$1,695. Take advantage of Early Bird Registration (by April 30, 2025) for a 10% discount.

Please note that this is our first tuition increase since our inception in 2016, and even with this adjustment, our tuition remains a deeply discounted rate compared to similar programs.

For the 2025 STEAM Leadership Conference, we've implemented a new policy mandating a non-refundable* deposit of \$250 to reserve your place and qualify for scholarship funding. This measure is essential for both attendees and the Project Fibonacci Foundation, Inc., as it affirms your intention to participate and helps us manage resources effectively while reducing potential costs linked to last-minute cancellations.

WHY THE DEPOSIT IS ESSENTIAL

The Project Fibonacci Foundation, Inc., accepts both checks and credit cards for payments related to the conference. Please be aware that an additional 3% will be charged for credit card transactions to cover processing fees.

REFUND POLICY

Payments made towards the conference are fully refundable up until June 27, 2025. Should a scholar find themselves unable to attend the conference, they are eligible to receive a refund for all payments made, with the exception of the non-refundable deposit.

TUITION ASSISTANCE & SCHOLARSHIPS

Personal Statement Essay

Write an essay detailing why you should be chosen to receive funds to attend the 2025 STEAM Leadership Conference. Highlight your passions, your achievements, community involvement, and how attending the conference will contribute to your personal and career goals.

Vision for the Future Essay

In a rapidly changing world, the workforce is significantly transforming due to technological advancements and global market shifts. It is vital to identify and develop the skills necessary for a robust and adaptable workforce. Write an essay exploring essential skills for a stronger future workforce, addressing at least two of the following elements:

- Emerging Technology and AI: Discuss how technologies like AI, automation, and data analytics are reshaping jobs. Identify in-demand technical skills and their significance.
- Relevance of Your Preferred Subjects: Highlight your favorite subjects and their relation to future workforce needs. Explain how knowledge in these areas prepares individuals for new challenges.
- Importance of Soft Skills: Analyze soft skills such as communication, leadership, and critical thinking. Discuss their integration into education and professional development for workforce readiness.
- Societal and Educational Shifts: Reflect on how society and education can adapt to prepare individuals for future careers, emphasizing interdisciplinary learning and lifelong education.

This includes, but is not limited to:


- Damages to hotel property or conference facilities.
